

# **Mammal Nests**





### **Harvest Mouse**



- Ball-shaped nest, 5-10cm wide
- 30cm 1.5m above the ground
- Attached to the stalks of grasses, cereals or rushes





## Hedgehog

- Made from leaves, grass and moss
- Summer 'day nests' are built in the grass
- Winter 'hibernation nests' are 50cm wide
- Winter nests are built under a hedge, shed or in a tree hole or rabbit hole



## **Rabbit**

- **Underground network of tunnels**
- Many entrance holes
- Holes are 8-20cm wide
- In loose soil, which is easy to dig
- Often on slopes
- Maybe in the roots of a large tree





Badger. Underground network of tunnels

- Many entrance holes
- Holes are 20-30cm wide, football-sized
- Often in sandy soil
- Large heaps of soil and dirty bedding of dry grass, lie in piles outside







- Deer do not build a nest
- Trample down grass and vegetation, often turning round in circles, like a dog
- Keep their young hidden in the undergrowth in bracken or tall grasses

## **Harvest Mouse**
